

DO YOU HAVE FIBROMYALGIA?

SDSU Researchers are recruiting adults ages 18-65 for a Chronic Pain and Brain Study

The study will examine the impact of chronic fibromyalgia on cognitive and neural functions

Looking for Participants who:

- 1. Have been diagnosed with **fibromyalgia** and have been experiencing widespread pain for 3 months or longer, OR
- 2. Have no history of a chronic pain condition, or any episodes of pain in the past year that have limited daily activities, or required pain medication
 - Qualified participants will be interviewed (~15 min) and will be asked to complete a battery of questionnaires (up to 40 min). They will take part in an electroencephalography (EEG) recording (~1.5 hrs) and a magnetic resonance (MRI) scanning session at SDSU (~1.5 hrs).
 - Participants will receive 25\$/hr for participating in the study.
 - Participants must be 18 65 yrs old, right-handed, able to have an MRI. Women who wish to participate cannot be pregnant or lactating.
