Brain Imaging Study

The study will use magnetic resonance imaging (MR) to examine structural and functional changes as a function of alcohol drinking levels and behavioral traits.

Qualified participants will be requested to complete a battery of questionnaires (up to 1 hr) and take part in an MRI scanning session (~2.5 hrs) at the SDSU Imaging Center. They will be contacted again after 6 and 12 months with brief follow-up questionnaires.

Participants will receive \$25/hr + bonus for completing the study

Participants must be: 18 - 30 yrs old, healthy, right-handed, able to have an MRI
